2019 Student Art Show Information and Requirements

Art Judging and Awards

Artwork will be judged according to the Visual Arts Standards set forth by the Ohio Department of Education. One piece from each show will be selected to add to the ESC Gallery. Awards will be presented by the following grade ranges: K-4, 5-8, and 9-12. The top five students from each grade range will be awarded according to Best of Show, Reserve Best of Show, or Honorable Mention. The Best of Show artist of each grade level will have an opportunity to have their work included in the CCESC permanent art gallery and receive a \$25 honorarium.

Art Submission Requirements

- All hanging pieces of artwork should have at least a 1 inch mat or border.
- Sculpted pieces of artwork will be displayed on black-clothed tables. A white mat should be used under each piece and include the label information listed below.
- Each displayed item must be accompanied by a label on the front lower right corner which includes the following information:
 1. Student Names
 2. Grade Level
 3. School District and Building
 4. Art Teacher
 5. Medium Used
- **Artwork must be delivered to the ESC during the week of January 28, 2019 through February 1, 2019.**

Teachers do not need to display the pieces. ESC staff will display the artwork. All pieces of artwork will be picked up by either the student or art teacher on the evening of the reception.

- Occasionally a student does not wish to sell their winning artwork. Please indicate on the back of artwork if student does not wish to sell his/her work.
