## Nonviolent Crisis Intervention Training - Day One

*(You will be certified in  
De-escalation only after Day 1 training)*

The emphasis is on early intervention and nonphysical methods for preventing or managing disruptive behavior. Personal safety techniques for staff are also demonstrated and practiced in this seminar to prepare staff to safely remove themselves and others from a dangerous situation. You will learn:

- How to identify behaviors that could lead to a crisis.
- How to most effectively respond to each behavior to prevent the situation from escalating.
- How to use verbal and nonverbal techniques to defuse hostile behavior and resolve a crisis before it becomes violent.
- How to cope with your own fear and anxiety.
- How to use principals of personal safety to avoid injury if behavior becomes physical.

## Nonviolent Physical Crisis Intervention Training - Day Two

\*\*Day Two is required within 14 days of Day One training for certification\*\*

*Pre-requisite: Attend Day 1 Training*

This training expands on crisis intervention methods to include the study and practice of Nonviolent Physical Crisis Intervention methods, used as a last resort when a student becomes an immediate danger to self or others. You will learn:

- When it's appropriate to physically intervene.
- How to develop team intervention strategies and techniques.
- How to assess the physical and psychological well-being of those involved in a crisis.
- How to safely and effectively control and transport a student.
- How to maintain rapport with the acting-out student.
- Key steps for debriefing after a crisis.

*(You will be certified in De-escalation and  
Restraint Training after Day 1 & Day 2 training)*

## Nonviolent Crisis Intervention Training - Key Point Refresher

- Navigate through each level and make connections between core concepts.
- Focus on helping participants apply the information to the challenges they face.
- Bridge and integrate concepts for a broader understanding of crisis development.
- Generate lively discussion and idea sharing.
